5:30 PM - Doors Open - Sign-In, Registration, & Organized Games (30 min.)

Children will be required to sign-in upon entrance to the Christian Life Center on Wednesday nights. For the safety and supervision of all, parents are asked to drop off children no earlier than 5:30 pm. Children will be directed to organized games after sign-in. If students do not wish to participate during the recreational time, they may be dropped off just prior to 6:00 pm for the regular meeting. Students will be required to participate in an organized activity if arriving at 5:30 pm.

Kindergarten - Class Color: Red
1st & 2nd Grade - Class Color: Green
3rd & 4th Grade - Class Color: Orange
5th & 6th Grade - Class Color: Blue
7th & 8th Grade - Class Color: Yellow

Primary teachers and assistants will gather and assist students during opening times with designated colors and areas for each class. Classes and various ministries will rotate to lead pledges, prayer, recitations, etc.

6:15 PM - Fellowship Meal

Parents should notify the leaders of any food allergies upon registration.

6:30 PM - Bible Lesson with Primary & Assistant Teacher

Classes will be led by a Primary teacher and an Assistant Teacher with both remaining in each classroom to ensure safety and good classroom management. The Bible will be taught as the true, inherent and literal Word of God using engaging, proven curriculum.

7:00 PM - Memory Verse Study

Each child will work on weekly memory verses.

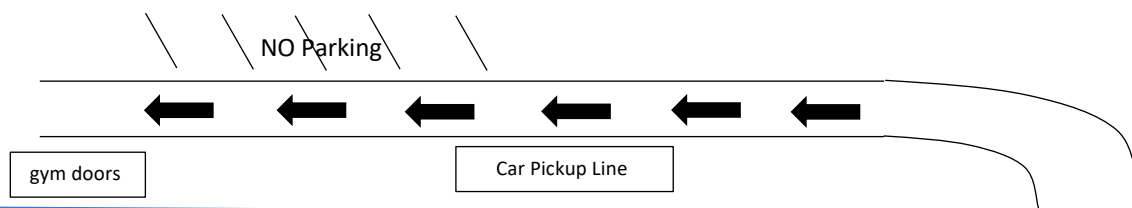
7:10 PM - Prayer Time

To increase safety for our children, we are requesting that parents create a car pickup line similar to school processes. HKids leaders will be stationed outside and at the entrance to assist children to their vehicles. If parking is required, please carefully pass the pickup line on the right side and park toward the rear of the gravel lot. When entering from the highway, follow the paved drive to the right, create a single-file line beginning at the gym doors, up the hill, wrapping around the front entrance. There will be a leader to greet you as you pull up to the double doors and call your child to your vehicle. Out of respect for the leaders' and workers' time, we appreciate your on-time pickup of **7:15 pm**.
